

The Honorable Phyllis C. Borzi

Ms. Borzi was the Assistant Secretary of Labor for the Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) in the Obama Administration from 2009 until 2017. EBSA regulates approximately 700,000 private-sector employer-sponsored retirement plans, approximately 2.3 million health plans, and a other plans providing benefits to approximately 150 million Americans.

In that capacity, Ms. Borzi oversaw implementation of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Ms. Borzi also represented the Secretary of Labor in the Secretary's role as statutory trustee for the Social Security and Medicare Trust Funds and as chair of the Board of the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation.

Previously, Ms. Borzi was a research professor in the Department of Health Policy at George Washington University. She also was of counsel with the Washington, D.C. law firm of O'Donoghue & O'Donoghue LLP, representing primarily jointly-trusted multiemployer plans.

From 1979 to 1995, Ms. Borzi served as pension and employee benefit counsel for the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Education and Labor.
